Platte Ranger District** has been outstanding!

On **September 21st, 2019** the **Trailblazers** will again be **partnering** with the **S. Platte Ranger District** in the **BCRA** of the Pike National Forest. We will be **completing** the **re-alignment** of the **extreme lower segment of Green Mtn. Trail** immediately above Meadows Group Upper Campground to **correct fall-line erosion** in the legacy tread & **improve sustainability**. We'll be hiking in from the Colorado Trail Trailhead just below Meadows Group Campground entrance, however, If the gate to Meadows Group Campground is open, proceed to the far end of the Upper Campground. Please review a bit of detail below for our 9/21/2019 Trail Day.

Directions . . .

- **From Denver** take U.S. 285 south to County Highway 126 at Pine Junction. From **Pine Junction, CO** turn **South** on **County Hwy. 126** and proceed through Pine Grove and Buffalo Creek for approximately 13.5 miles. Turn **West** onto **Forest Service Rd. 550** (gravel road) from **County Hwy. 126** for approximately 5.5 mi. to the entrance drive for **Meadows Group Campground** on your left. Turn left as directed by signage for approx. ¼ mi. to the Colorado Trail Trailhead. If the gate to Meadows Group Campground is open, proceed to the far end of the Upper Campground.
- **Look** for the **Trailblazers' tent canopies** on the **right** near the entrance to Meadows Group Campground.
- Plan your travel to **arrive** around **8:00 am** to get fueled up and meet everyone.
- **Please note** that **FS Rd. 550** is gravel so **be mindful of any local traffic and respectful to local residents, hikers, and bikers.**

Volunteers need to bring . . .

- **Enthusiasm** and **energized muscles** to help us build these great trails for our community!
- **Wear** comfortable work clothes . . . **long pants, long sleeve shirt, and boots!**
- Bring a **lunch, snacks and lots of water** for during the day while on trail!
- Don't forget **work gloves, a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, and jacket**, just in case!
